- strain induced reduction

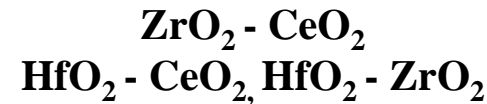
- Redox Processes

- Specific surface redox w/metal modification e.g. STM Au- Fe_3O_4

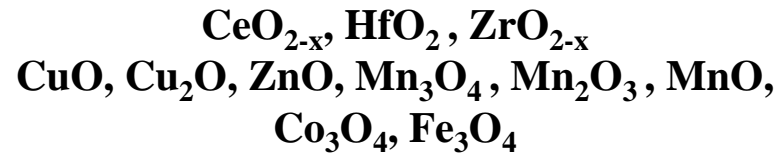
- Lattice Parameter (CeO_2 , Cu_2O , MnO)

- pressure (B)

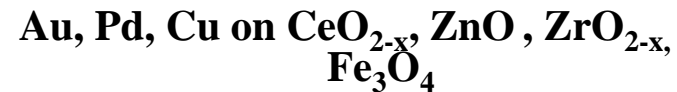
